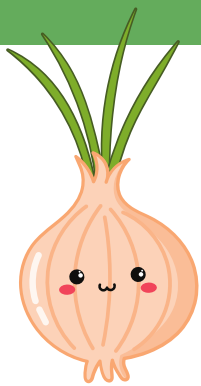


Green Onion

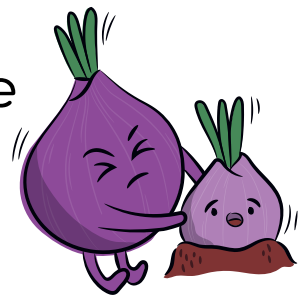
Look: Green onions have elongated, cylindrical stems with tubular leaves & a miniature bulb. Both the bulb and bright green tops are edible.

Taste: The stem has a grassy, sweet, and slightly pungent flavor. The white portions of the onion will have a sharper taste. They are crunchy and subtly chewy when eaten raw.

Touch: The green onion's base is white, smooth, crisp, and lightly aqueous. The stem is hollow. You can cut it and use it as a straw!



Most green onions are just immature onions of other kinds!
