

Pepino Melon



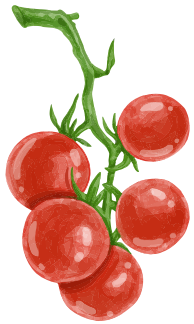
Look: Pepinos are small to medium sized fruit and are round to pear shaped. The skin ripens to a pale yellowish with purple striping.

Taste: Pepinos are filled with edible seeds. They release a sweet scent when ripe and have a grassy taste when unripe.

Touch: The skin is smooth, glossy, and firm but is still easily bruised and damaged when handled roughly.



Pepino melons are part of the nightshade family, closely related to tomatoes, eggplants, and peppers.
