

Minneola Tangelo

Look:

Minneola tangelos are large fruits, and have a round to oblate shape with a pronounced, elongated neck on the stem-end. The rind is thin, glossy, and bright red-orange. The flesh is a bright orange and usually seedless.

Taste:

Minneola tangelos have a sweet-tart flavor with the tangy, floral acidity of grapefruit mixed with the fragrant, honeyed flavor of tangerines.

Touch:

Minneola tangelos have a smooth and lightly pebbled surface texture. The rind is easily peeled revealing soft and juicy flesh.



Minneola Tangelos are a hybrid between a grapefruit and a tangerine.

Minneola Tangelos are nicknamed "Honeybell" due to its bell shape.
