Look: The Bosc Pear is shaped like a teardrop. The skin is brown to a golden tan and the flesh is white.

Taste: Bosc Pears are juicy, crunchy, and very sweet. They have a hint of woody spice.

Touch: The skin of the Bosc Pear is thick and feels rough. The flesh inside is moist.



The Bosc Pear is found in many historical paintings by Leonardo Da Vinci and Vincent Van Gogh.
