

D'Anjou Pear

Look:

D'Anjou pears have an egg-shaped appearance that is wide on the bottom and tapers to a narrow rounded top with a thick neck and dark brown stem. Their skin is bright green and the flesh inside is cream-colored.

Taste:

Anjou pears are juicy and soft with subtle, sweet flavor with hints of lemon and lime.

Touch:

The skin is smooth and firm, inside the flesh is slightly gritty and soft.



The D' Anjou pear belongs to the Rosaceae family, which includes roses and apples.
